RESULTS OF GLOBAL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION (GTSE) AUG 2015

In order to identify and award the meritorious students, Delhi School of Professional Studies and Research (DSPSR) conducts the Global Talent Search Examination twice every year, in the beginning of every semester. The merit list on the basis of the marks scored in the examination is prepared and the top three scorers are given cash prize of Rs. 1500, Rs. 1000 and Rs. 500 respectively. Also, the book bank facility is given to all the meritorious students. In the GTSE examination held in the month of August 2015, a total number of 171 students participated. Out of these, top 74 students (in order of merit) availed the facility of Book Bank. BLOOD DONATION AND THALASSEMIA CHECK-UP CAMP

The Rotaract Club at DSPSR organized a Blood Donation and Thalassemia check-up camp in the college premises on 30th September 2015, to mark the death Anniversary of Late Sh. Madhav Rao Sindhia former Union Railway Minister. Three doctors along with helping staff were invited from the Rotary Blood Bank, Tughlakabad in order to conduct the check-up and blood donation. This was followed by a keynote speech by Mr. Rohit Kumar, Director of blood Donation Rotary District 3102 which revolved around Thalassemia awareness. Prior to the



event, the college witnessed a week long Thalassemia awareness campaign where various interactive sessions were held to highlight the advantages of thalassemia check up and students played a key role by making various posters and pamphlets in order to sensitize everyone about the disease. An overwhelming response by the students and staff members for the blood donation and thalassemia check-up made the event a huge success.
